

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM 2020

We are pleased to inform you that the Sacraments of **Reconciliation** and **First** Holy Holy Communion will be taking place in COMMUNION Term 3 at St Christopher's Church, Panania.



The structure of the program will be three weeks of Reconciliation lessons, followed by the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. A week later, this will be followed by three lessons for the Sacrament of the Eucharist, followed by a Student Retreat and the celebration of the First Holy Communion. Therefore, by the end of Term 3 your child will have received both Sacraments.

This year, enrolments for the Sacraments will be online. Please go to the St Christopher's website and enrol your child for the Reconciliation Program - https:// www.stchristopherpanania.org.au/ The Enrolment Form is a simple Step by Step document, taking about 10 mins to complete (Enrolments for the Sacrament of the Eucharist will be open on the 23rd August, 2020).

There will be a Parent Preparation Evening on Wednesday 29th July at 6pm or Thursday 30th July at 6pm in St Christopher's Church. Please ensure that you attend one of these Parent Preparation Evenings as vital information regarding lessons, expectations and dates will be shared on those evenings. Attendance at Parent Preparation is compulsory and a prerequisite for enrolment in the program.
